Part IV: Analysis

A. SUMMARY OF BILL

Description of the bill with an emphasis on how it impacts local government.

This legislation would stop someone from using a court order to take money directly from the wages of a person who owes money, if the debt is because of medical bills.

Sec. 2 amends RCW 6.27.020 such that a writ of garnishment, including a writ for a continuing lien on earnings, may not be issued to an employer for the garnishment of the judgment debtor's earnings if the judgment arises from medical debt of the judgment debtor.

Sec. 3 amends RCW 6.27.060 with regard to the current statutory requirements, the affidavit filed by a creditor when applying for a writ of garnishment must include a statement as to whether or not the judgment arises from medical debt of the judgment debtor.

Sec. 4 amends RCW 6.27.140 such that the notice of garnishment and debtor's rights that must be mailed to or served on an individual judgment debtor must include a statement that a garnishment against wages or other earnings may not be issued for medical debt.

This act would go into effect 90 days after the adjournment of the session in which it is passed.
