#### II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact

Sections 1 - 20: Amends multiple areas in chapter 18.79 RCW (Nursing Care) changing the title of Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner to Advanced Practice Nurse to align with national naming standards.

Sections 2, 3, 5-9, 11-13, 15, 17–20: Amends multiple areas in chapter 18.79 RCW (Nursing Care) changing the Nursing Care Quality Assurance Commission to the Washington Board of Nursing to align with national naming standards and Nursing Licensure Compact standards.

Section 21: This act takes effect June 30, 2027.

Current law RCW 43.70.250 (License fees for professions, occupations, and businesses) requires the Washington Board of Nursing (board) to charge a fee to generate sufficient revenue to fully support the costs of administering its licensing activities. The board does not anticipate the need to increase licensing fees to implement this bill. The board will monitor program fund balances and adjust fees over a six (6) year period to ensure that fees are sufficient to cover program expenditures.

### Rulemaking:

The board will adopt rules reflecting new titles of Advanced Practice Nurse and Washington Board of Nursing. The board anticipates utilizing a team of subject matter experts to implement this bill. This team will consist of the program manager and a community engagement specialist to identify underreached communities and engage them in the rulemaking process. This process will include two meetings with interested parties as well as one formal rules hearing, all held virtually, and will take approximately 12 months to complete. The board anticipates providing the rules hearing announcement and materials in both English and Spanish and providing ASL and Spanish interpretation services at the rules hearing. Costs include staff, associated expenses (including goods and services, travel, intra-agency, and indirect charges), and Office of Attorney General support in the amount of \$4,000.

FY 2025 one-time costs will be 0.2 FTE and \$29,000 (02G).

Office of Innovation and Technology (OIT):

Starting in FY 2026, OIT staff will be required to make changes to Healthcare Enforcement and Licensing Modernization Solution (HELMS) software program.

FY 2026: 0.1 FTE and \$26,000 (02G)

FY 2027: 0.1 FTE and \$22,000 (02G)

FY 2028 and beyond: 0.1 FTE and \$7,000 (02G)
