Section 1 is a new section added to chapter 79.24 RCW that establishes the Washington state law enforcement memorial names committee. This committee shall determine which names of fallen law enforcement officers shall appear on the Washington state law enforcement memorial. Approved names shall be forwarded to Department of Enterprise Services (DES) for inclusion on the memorial.

This has indeterminate fiscal impact to the Department of Enterprise Services.

The Department of Enterprise Services (DES) is not presently responsible for the engraving of names of fallen law enforcement officers on the Law Enforcement Memorial, nor does DES have staff who are qualified to do this work. In order to implement this legislation DES would need to hire a contractor to engrave approved names on the memorial. We assume the cost to range from \$2,000 to \$3,000 per name. Due to the uncertain nature of the likelihood and timing of fallen law enforcement officers, as well as the newly established Committee's referral of names to DES, DES has no way to predict the number of names to be added annually. Therefore, we assume an indeterminate fiscal impact, likely to be less than \$50,000 per year.
