Part IV: Analysis

A. SUMMARY OF BILL

Description of the bill with an emphasis on how it impacts local government.

This legislation would allow Lewis County to utilize fair property for county purposes as well as fair purposes. Funds relating to fair activities must be managed and accounted for the same as other funds of Lewis County. The Board may acquire real property for fair and county purposes and may construct and maintain improvements for those purposes.
