Part IV: Analysis

A. SUMMARY OF BILL

Description of the bill with an emphasis on how it impacts local government.

This bill prohibits places of public accommodation from denying a service animal trainer the right to be accompanied by a service animal trainee in any area that is open to the public. This bill also establishes rights and requirements regarding service animals and service animal trainees.

Sec. 1 amends RCW 59.60.040 to add the clarification that the definition of "any place of public resort, accommodation, assemblage, or amusement" does not apply to "service animal trainers" and "service animal trainees" in the housing or lodging of transient guests. Definitions of "service animal trainee" and "service animal trainer" are provided.

Sec. 2 amends RCW 49.60.214 to allow enforcement officers to issue civil infractions to persons who represent that an animal is a service animal trainee when the animal does not meet the definition.

Sec. 3 amends RCW 49.60.215 to allow places of accommodation to charge for damages, require that service animal trainees to be under control, and allow trainers to accompany service animal trainees. Signage may be posted which state that violations may result in a civil infraction up to \$500.

The bill takes effect 90 days after adjournment of the session in which the bill is passed.

B. SUMMARY OF EXPENDITURE IMPACTS

This bill would not impact local government expenditures.

This bill allows local governments to post signage that would include the amount of a civil infraction. There may be costs to post signage, but this is not a requirement due to the local option.
